While on their journey, John spent time talking to past business associates whom the Groves stopped to see along the way. These conversations combined with a tragic event-two workers being electrocuted on scaffolding when the Groves were going to the Hoover Dam- John discovered an infinite marketplace for a product that could swiftly and securely elevate individuals in the air to accomplish maintenance and other construction functions.

Upon returning from their travels, John formed a partnership with two friends and purchased a metal fabrication company in McConnellsburg, Pennsylvania. In 1970, starting operations with a crew of twenty employees, they designed and sold the first JLG aerial work platform. The business incorporates some of the simple design elements of that original lift into current versions.

Since then, JLG Forklifts have come a long way from when Mr. John L. Grove returned from his fateful cross-country journey and since the first JLG aerial platform entered the market. As of today, the company has extended itself into several international marketplaces and continues to develop innovative equipment to guarantee that clients are able to become safer and more well-organized within their workplace.
